

Ladies Indoor Social Hockey League

Terms & Conditions

1. No provisional bookings will be taken. Places can only be secured on receipt of completed registration forms and payment.
2. Places will be filled on a first come first served basis.
3. All medical conditions must be made aware to the League Administrator prior to games starting each week.
4. Ladies Indoor Social Hockey is open to non-club members only. If you are a registered player with any hockey club in Ireland, you are not eligible to take part.
5. The only exception to Rule 4 is if you are registered with a club as a Veterans player.
6. Each team must register and sign in each week with the League Administrator.
7. Shin pads are mandatory for all players and gum shields are strongly recommended.
8. The dates and times of Boot Camp and the League are available on <http://www.hockey.ie/development/socialhockey/index.htm>
9. All valuables must be left at home. The IHA does not accept liability for the loss or damage to any property belonging to the participants during Boot Camp or the League.
10. The IHA reserves the right to cancel part of or the entire Boot Camp or League with all payments refunded on a prorated basis.
11. If a player is unable to participate, a full refund will be given upon 14 days or more notice or if a Medical Certificate is produced. Within 14 days of the League or Boot Camp commencing, the IHA reserve the right to retain full payment.
12. If a player is injured during the course of Boot Camp and/or the League (whilst taking part or elsewhere), the IHA reserve the right to retain full payment.
13. Whilst the IHA will ensure that a first kit is available to players, it cannot guarantee the presence of a qualified first aider.
14. Participants play at their own risk. The IHA disclaims liability in the event of any accident or mishap during the league.
15. Whilst the IHA has public liability insurance, players may want to take out their own personal injury insurance.
16. The IHA reserves the right to suspend any participant that does not abide by the rules and puts them or others at risk.
17. Each team is responsible for ensuring that a minimum of five players are available to play their team's fixtures. A penalty may ensue for any teams that fail to do so.
